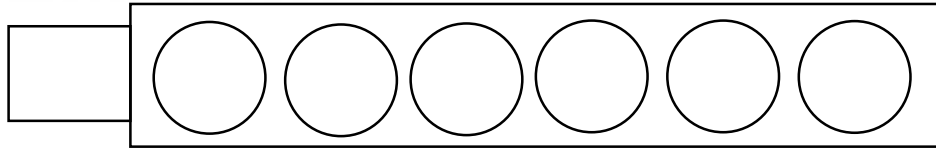




BREW'D PUB

1. MI BERRY VICE

Raspberry/Blueberry Wheat Ale. A sweet, tart refreshing fruit wheat beer fermented with red and black raspberries as well as blueberries. Arcadia Ales. ABV: 6.3%. Pint: \$6.50. Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$16.

2. GOLD LEAF LAGER

Gold Leaf Lager is pale gold, light to medium bodied with subtle fresh bread notes, and a clean crisp finish. Devil's Backbone Brewing Co. ABV: 4.5%. IBU: 17. Pint: \$6.50. Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$16.

3. PAHOEHOE

Coconut Ale. Smooth and creamy with with notes of coconut and vanilla. Two Brothers Artisan Brewing. ABV: 5.2%. Pint: \$6.50. Taster: \$2.20. Growler: \$18.

4. THE KRAGLE

West-coast style IPA. Assertive and hop forward. Bright and juicy with a fresh, dry finish. Hopped with Simcoe, Citra, Columbus and Calypso. Free Will. ABV: 6.6%. Pint: \$6.50. Taster: \$2.20. Growler: \$18.

5. DAD BOD

A refreshing and highly drinkable blend of tropical and citrus flavors and aromas culled from a vibrant spectrum of hops ABV: 8.5%. Snifter: \$6.50. Taster: \$3.25. Growler: \$24.

6. HOP'SOLUTELY

TRIPLE IPA. Utterly smooth with a powerfully hoppy presence. Fegley's Brewworks. Allentown, PA. ABV: 11.5%. Snifter: \$7.00. Taster: \$3.50. Growler: \$24.

7. PIKELAND PILS

A northern German-style Pilsner brewed with imported German pils malt and hopped with German and Czech hops. ABV: 4.9%. Pint: \$6.50, Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$16.

8. SUNFLOWER PILS

This Czech-style pilsner is brewed with pilsner malt and sunflower petals alongside the spicy and floral notes of Saaz hops. ABV: 5.2%. Pint: \$6.50. Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$16.

9. TEN FIDY

Imperial Stout. One of the darkest, most flavorful brews you'll enjoy. Definitely a sipping beer. ABV: 10.5%. Snifter: \$6.50, Taster: \$2.50. Growler: \$24.

10. HAGERWEISS

Hefeweizer. Brewed with 100% German ingredients, this refreshing wheat ale is unfiltered and unfettered. Antietam Brewery. ABV: 5.3%. Pint: \$6.50, Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$16.

11. MANGO SUPRISE

Mango-Infused IPA. Tropical aromas of mango, pineapple, papaya and citrus gently play off a bright hop profile. Arcadia Brewing Company. ABV: 6.5%. Pint: \$6.50, Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$16.

12. 1605 IRISH RED

Irish-style Red Ale brewed with British malts & hops. Perfectly balanced, with subtle notes of caramel. Antietam Brewing. ABV: 5.0%. Pint: \$6.00. Taster: \$2.00. Growler: \$16.

13. DOG DAYS

Dortmunder Lager. Brewed in the style of Dortmund, Germany, this golden lager has a caramel malt character. Two Brothers Brewing Co. ABV: 5.1%. Pint: \$6.50. Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$16.

14. WOBBLE IPA

American IPA. Golden color, subtle malt, big complex citrus and piney hop notes throughout. Two Brothers Artisan Brewing. Illinois. ABV: 6.3%. Pint: \$7.00, Snifter: \$2.50. Growler: \$16.

15. PATIENTLY PALE ALE

Refreshing Seasonal Pale Ale, dry hopped with Simcoe. Red Shedman. ABV: 6.1% Pint: \$6.50. Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$16.

16. APRICOT WHEAT

Wheat & Barley ale. A hint of apricot gives this beer a pleasant nose, fruity finish. Ithaca Beer Co.. ABV: 4.9% Pint: \$6.00. Taster: \$2.00. Growler: \$16.

17. MILK STOUT

Milk Stout. Traditional full-bodied stout brewed with lactose (milk sugar). Since lactose is unfermentable by brewer's yeast, it remains in beer ABV: 5.7%. Pint: \$7.00. Taster: \$3.50. Growler: \$18.

18. LOS LOCOS

Los Locos is a sessionable, refreshing lager with a hint of corn sweetness, a dash of sea salt and the perfect kick of natural lime juice. Epic Brewing Company. ABV: 5.2%. Pint: \$7.00. Taster: \$2.50. Growler: \$18.

19. BROWN ALE

A solid, outstanding sweet Brown Ale. Dead on style, and excellent in execution. Duck Rabbit Brewery. ABV: 5.6%. Pint: \$6.50. Taster: \$2.25. Growler: \$18.

20. WHITSUN

Unfiltered Wheat Ale. Brewed in the style of a mid-19th century English Festival Ale. Arcadia Brewing. ABV: 6.2%. Pint: \$6.00. Taster: \$2.00. Growler: \$16.

21. TART TEN

Sour Dubbel Ale. If you like sours, this is your jam. Victory. ABV: 10%. Snifter: \$7.00. Taster: \$3.50. Growler: \$24.
